1. The Semester Fees Covers

Admission/Registration Fee, Tuition Fee, Enrolment Card Fee, Library Fee, Internet Charges, Regular Semester Examinations Fee, Application Form Processing & Conduct of Seminars/Viva Voce and Comprehensive Examination Fee.

2. The Semester Fees NOT Covers

Duplicate Student ID/Enrolment Card Fee for ME/MS & PhD: Rs. 5,000.00
Special (One Time Chance) Examinations Fee for ME/MS: Rs. 20,000.00 per Subject
Re-registration Fee for PhD Students: Rs. 40,000.00 per Subject

3. General Policy & Liability Period

The maximum period to complete the ME/MS degree program is 04 years (08 semesters), and PhD degree program is 08 years (16 semesters) from the initial date of admission.

All ME/MS & PhD students are required to pay the prescribed semester fee of Rs. 80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand Only) for each semester, starting from the 1st semester up to the date of the final examination/viva-voce. A full semester's fee will be charged even single day after the end of the previous semester. No waiver of the semester fee shall be granted to any student under any circumstances.

4. Payment Deadline & Consequences of Default

It is mandatory for all ME/MS and PhD students to deposit the semester fees/dues prior to the commencement of each semester's classes, research work, and conduct of seminars/ viva-voce & examinations. Failure to comply will result in students being barred from appearing in the relevant seminar/ viva-voce or examinations, and their admission shall be suspended until all outstanding dues are cleared. Non-compliance with the above policy will lead to the matter being referred to the relevant statutory bodies or competent authorities for consideration of cancellation of admission, and/or the initiation of any other necessary action as deemed appropriate by the University.
